GUIDANCE ON THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS & RECORDED IMAGES FOR CHILDREN/YOUNG PEOPLE

During your child's involvement at the Kent & Masters Quest National Championships we may wish to take photographs/video recordings that involve your child/young person. The photographs may be used by British Dressage for display, publications, on the British Dressage website or by the media. Photographs will not be released to third parties outside of the BEF, nor given to any companies for promotional purposes without your consent.

Photography or filming will only take place with the permission of the Organiser of the Quest National Championships and under appropriate supervision. When filming or photography is carried out by the news media, children will only be named if there is a particular reason to do so (e.g. they have won a prize) and home addresses will never be given out. Images that might cause embarrassment or distress will not be used.

Before taking any photographs/film of your child/young person we need your permission. This form is to be signed by the parent/guardian of a child/young person under the age of 18, along with the child or young person. Please note that if you are the parent/guardian of more than one child/young person under the age of 18 competing at the Quest National Championships you will need to complete separate forms for each.

- The BEF and British Dressage recognise the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all children/young people.
- As part of our commitment to ensure the safety of children/young people we will not permit photographs, video images or other images of children/young people to be taken or used without the consent of the parent/guardian and the child/young person.
- British Dressage will follow the guidance for the use of images of children/young people as detailed within the BEF Policy and Procedures.
- British Dressage will take steps to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes they are intended which is the promotion and publicity of the activities of British Dressage.
- If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform your Regional Development Officer (RDO) or BD Youth Representative who are British Dressage Welfare Officers.
- We will not at any time release photographs to any third party organisation without first obtaining your consent.
- If at any time either the parent/guardian or the child/young person wishes the data to be removed from the website, seven days notice must be given to the British Dressage Welfare Officer (RDO or BD Youth Representative) after which the data will be removed. If there is a child/young person in the background of a photograph/recording who is subject to a protection order or for whom consent has not been given, it will be removed immediately upon the Office being informed.
