RULES AND REGULATIONS

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society. NPS rules for showing apply. Riders of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. All riders while mounted must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.

All ponies must be registered by the closing date of entries in the appropriate section of the BCPS Stud Book or Register, in the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Society or in the Part-Bred Register where applicable.

A copy of the BCPS Showing Rules is available from the BCPS Secretary. **ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ THESE RULES.** It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to enter their ponies correctly in the appropriate class.

Neither the organisers of this event nor the BCPS, nor any agent or representative thereof accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness or any other loss of any kind whether financial or otherwise suffered by any horse, pony, spectator, land, buildings, person, animal or any other property of any type whether caused by negligence, breach of contract, breach of trust or in any other way whatsoever.

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors shall, to the extent allowed by law, indemnify this Show, Vale View Equestrian, its Officials, Servants and Assistants against all actions, proceedings, claims or otherwise in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the Show, and each entry form **MUST** be signed as having accepted these conditions.

The Committee reserves the right to cancel, amalgamate or divide classes as and when necessary. The Committee reserves the right to accept substitute ponies.

BRITISH CONNEMARA PONY SOCIETY

RULES FOR SHOWING

1. No Connemara Pony may be shown after the age of six months unless it is registered in an recognised Connemara Pony Stud Book.
2. No Foal may be shown under the age of four weeks.
3. No entire male may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after the 1st June in the year in which he attains the age of three years unless he has been registered as a Stallion in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society. Stallions registered after 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2.
4. No female or Gelding may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies after 1st January in the year in which it attains the age of four years unless it has been registered as an adult pony in the BCPS Stud Book or the Stud Book of a recognised Connemara Pony Society. Mares and Geldings registered after the 1st March 2007 must be registered in Class 1 or Class 2, with the exception of Geldings registered as adults in BCPS Stud Book in 2007 and 2008.
5. Unless entered in a class specifically for Over-height Connemaras, no Pure-Bred Connemara Pony exceeding 148cms in height may be shown or take part in any competition restricted to Connemara or Registered Mountain and Moorland Ponies within the jurisdiction of the BCPS.
6. Where it is reported to the BCPS that this may have occurred, the society may require the animal to be measured or re-measured in accordance with the rules of the Joint Measurement Board Ltd. The penalty for contravening the above rule may be cancellation of the registration of the animal concerned.

All Horses/Ponies should be vaccinated and have the minimum of their annual booster or have had their 2nd inoculation within a minimum of 7 days before competing at Vale View

Pre-Entries close 5th July 2019. No entries between 5th July and Show Day will be accepted. Entries on the morning of Show Day are accepted on inspection of Passports. Riders and Owners must be members of their respective Breed Society, NPS, P(UK), Showing Register or BSPS. Ponies must not exceed the height limit as stipulated by the British Connemara Pony Society. All animals competing in Mountain and Moorland Ridden classes will be required to be in possession of a current/valid JMB height certificate within 28 days of notification of qualification from HOYS or by closing date of HOYS entries, whichever is sooner. Failure to do so may result in qualification of the pony being removed at the discretion of GML. Riders of Stallions must have obtained their 14th Birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Marks will be awarded in the following way. Show, Freedom of Action – 50 maximum. Breed Type and Conformation - 50 maximum. In the case of equality, the pony with the highest show, freedom of action will be deemed the winner. If there is still equality at this point, then the Judges decision will be final.

Ponies/Horses will enter the ring individually and jump a course designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts, each jumping effort will be marked out of 5, 5 penalties will be incurred for each pole down or run out. Three refusals at any one fence will result in elimination (A maximum of 50 marks will be awarded for a clear round) Fall of pony or rider will result in elimination. There will be no mark awarded for conformation but a mark of 20 will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round. In the event of a tie the overall impression will determine the final placings.

WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

No change or rider or saddlery is allowed between phases or during a phase. A correctly fitting hard/skull cap to current BSI standard must be worn and securely fastened. Protective boots may be used for the jumping phase only. Bandages and protective pads on pony's feet are not allowed. Body Protectors are recommended.
