Horse Section – Allocated Tickets & Extras

Please note the following information regarding horse section access and wristbands:

* Each **in-hand/ridden horse** entry will receive **two equine wristbands**. These wristbands allow entry for the **rider/handler and one groom** into the equine collecting ring and equine show rings.

* Each **driving/heavy horse** entry will receive **three equine wristbands**. These wristbands allow entry for the **driver/handler, groom, and assistant** into the equine collecting ring and equine show rings.

Additional wristbands may be purchased at the reduced rate of **£15** when submitting your entries. Please note that these additional wristbands are **NOT EQUINE WRISTBANDS**. They will allow entry to the showgrounds and access to view classes from the spectator areas only, and **will not permit access to the equine collecting ring**.

For health, safety, and insurance reasons, there will be **STRICTLY NO buggies, prams, pushchairs, etc. permitted within the equine collecting ring**.

Access to the collecting ring will be **STRICTLY LIMITED to those wearing an official equine wristband only**.

We hope you understand that all friends and family attending to support competitors will still be able to enjoy clear views of the arenas and judging. Classes will be judged facing outwards towards the show, rather than towards the collecting ring, ensuring everyone can safely watch and support those they have come to see.

To be eligible for the Orsett Elite championship classes, each partnership needs to qualify for the finals, the combination will need to place 1st to 4th in two separate occasions in the same class at any of our qualifying shows. (List available on the website)

All qualifications will need to be registered before booking Orsett Elite Championship classes

To register your qualification please visit www.orsettsociety.co.uk/horse-section and click the "Register My Qualification" tab. You will need to complete the horse and rider details and attach both images of the results, which included placing, venue, class, and date. Please note, you can not register your qualification until both qualifiers have been obtained. We looked forward to seeing you in September!

ORSETT SHOW HEAVY HORSE APPEARANCE PAYMENTS

To qualify for appearance payments you must attend both Grand Parades or appearance money will be forfeit.

Orsett show appearance money must be collected and signed for within 45mins of the end of the supreme of show or it will be forfeited

SHIRE HORSE OF THE YEAR CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER

Shire Horse of the Year Championship Qualifier

Supported by the Shire Horse Society

The class is open purebred Shire Horse stallions, mares and geldings, 2 years old and over that are registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of the Shire Horse Society.

All Owners, Handlers and Exhibitors must be Members of the Shire Horse Society.

This class will be run in accordance with the Shire Horse Society guidelines, which for the avoidance of doubt will be considered rules for Horse of the Year Show and its qualifiers, however the general rules as set out within this Rule book will take precedence.

Additional Rules:

- i. Qualification will not pass below 5th place.
- ii. Horses must be entered in the name and ownership in which they are registered.
- iii. Horses should be turned out in a traditional manner, with flights.
- iv. Horse's docks must be covered with a fan of hair in accordance with the Shire Horse Society rules.
- v. The turning up of coats is not permitted, in accordance with the Shire Horse Society rulebook.
- vi. At the final and qualifiers, horses may have foot inspections carried out by a Shire Horse Society farrier and vet. Horses must be correctly shod in accordance with the shoeing standards, as detailed in The Shire Horse Society rulebook. Horses may be shown unshod.

vii. Horses that are part bred or from the Grade A, B or C Registers of the Shire Horse Society are not eligible to compete. Geldings must be registered in the Shire Horse Society Non-Breeding Register and must be pure bred e.g. not out of Grade B mares, and parentage verified.

BEST SHOD HEAVY HORSE AWARDS

The competition is sponsored by The Worshipful Company of Farriers and will run concurrently with judging of all the Heavy Horse Classes. The Judge will examine each horse before or during the line-up for preliminary judging, taking into consideration;

- (a) The condition of the feet
- (b) The making (or preparation) and fitting of the shoes
- (c) The Nailing and the position of the clips

Normal shoes and showing plates are equally acceptable, providing they are suitable for the horse.

The Worshipful Company of Farriers will award:

A Rosette and an Inscribed Card to the Winner in each Class

A brass plaque to the overall winner

A brass plaque to the Registered Farrier responsible for its feet and shoeing.

THE OVERALL WINNER WILL GO FORWARD FOR THE NATIONAL BEST SHOD COMPETITION.

SILVER SPOON

The Shire Horse Society is pleased to award to any Affiliated Society, a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Mare or Filly and a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Stallion at their Annual Show. Conditions of the Award are as follows: -

1. A Spoon and a Rosette for the Best Mare or Filly and a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Stallion (providing there is a separate class(es) for Stallions) exhibited in the Shire classes.
2. The winner of the Special Prize must be a member of the Shire Horse Society.
3. Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has been either suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
4. No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year.

The Shire Horse Society National Spring and Summer Shows being accepted.

5. THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.

6. The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.

7. The Council reserves the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society.

SESHA Subsidy Payments

Class 62 (Yearling) and Class 68 (Foal) – Shire Horse Only

£100 will be paid to every qualifying Foal and Yearling in these classes. Maximum 6 horses, horses placed 1st – 6th will qualify for Subsidy unless competitors opt not to claim subsidy. In which case, it will pass on to the next placed horse. Subsidy form MUST be completed. Only available for members who have been a member for 3 or more subsequent years.

When entering a Foal or Yearling and wish to claim the Subsidy please complete the Youngstock Subsidy Form. Available on request by emailing show_entries@sessa.org.uk.

Cups & Trophies

Winners of Cups and Trophies are responsible for having these engraved. All Cups and Trophies must be returned to the SESH A OFFICE at least 3 weeks prior to the following years show or at such a time that the committee shall decide. Reminders will be sent. In the event that any Cup or Trophy is lost or damaged the winner will be held responsible for the repair or replacement.

THE TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB ASSOCIATION

Classes 55-60

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS".

Traditional Classes (55-57) are open to all traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Traditional Finals at 'TOYS'. Part Bred Classes (58-60), are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is a traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgea.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

THE COLOURED HORSE & PONY SOCIETY (UK) - CHAPS (Classes 51-54)

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) Affiliation no 25-078. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify for both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members apply to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The following classes (54 to 59) are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only Skewbald's/Piebald's may compete these classes All Stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception. NB CHAPS (UK) Qualification Cards – please note competitors are responsible for completing their own qualification cards for relevant qualifications only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain from CHAPS (UK) Admin, and to carry their Qualification and Membership Cards. Qualification is presented as stated above BUT a horse/pony may only qualify once per season for each Final it is eligible for.

HACKNEY HORSE SOCIETY (Classes 7 & 9) are affiliated to the Hackney Horse Society. All horses/ponies must be registered in the studbook of the UK Hackney Horse Society or of a recognised Hackney Society abroad and all exhibitors must be members of the Hackney Horse Society. Minimum age of driver is open and novice classes will be 14 years at the date of show. Please note ruling for Novice Hackneys: To be eligible for a novice class the exhibit may not have been a Novice Champion at an Annual Breeds Show or Novice Hackney Horse or Pony of the Year. An animal can only be a Novice for three seasons from the start of their first show (Not consecutive seasons)

THE VICTORIA FOOD COMPANY OPEN PRIVATE DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIP This is a Victoria Food Company Driving Championship qualifier. The champion will qualify for the grand final to be held on Sunday 12th & 13th September 2026 at Bury Farm Equestrian Club, New Bury Farm, Mill Road, Slapton, Bucks, LU7 9BT. In the event that the champion has already qualified then the Reserve Champion to qualify. If the Reserve has also qualified, the rosette will be awarded to the Champion, once qualified, the horse, whip and vehicle may not be changed.

CONCOURS D' ELEGANCE SOCIETY OF GREAT BRITAIN (classes 39-40) First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Onley Equestrian Centre, Rugby, Warwickshire on Friday 25th and Saturday 26th September 2026. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. WELSH PONY AND COB SOCIETY

Classes 74-100

These rules/guidelines are aimed to assist Show Secretaries, Judges and Exhibitors participating at shows affiliated to the Welsh Pony and Cob Society and must take precedence over other societies' rules when WPCS bronze and silver medals are awarded.

4.1 Height

All ponies, four years old and over, come under the jurisdiction of the Joint Measurement Board (JMB). The following heights apply to the five sections of the Welsh Stud Book.

Section A Welsh Mountain Ponies Not exceeding 121.9 cm (12.0 hands)
Section B Welsh Ponies Not exceeding 137.2 cm (13.2 hands)
Section C Welsh Ponies (Cob Type) Not exceeding 137.2 cm (13.2 hands)
Section D Welsh Cobs No upper height limit
WPBR Welsh Part Bred Pony Not exceeding 148cm (14.2 hands)
WPBR Welsh Part bred Horse Over 148cm (14.2 hands)

4.2 - Freeze Branding The Society has no objection to ponies and cobs being freeze branded and this must not be seen as detrimental to animals in the show or sale ring and is encouraged by the Society.

4.3 Scarring as a result of accident or surgery should not be penalised in the show ring.

4.4 Age of Animal -Age is calculated from 1st January in the year of birth.

4.5 Soundness - If an animal entered in a class is, in the opinion of the Judge unsound or obese and where the welfare of the animal is at risk, the Judge shall, at their discretion, request the exhibitor to withdraw the animal from that class or stand it at the end of the line. The Judge's decision in this matter is final. The judge should politely communicate this to the exhibitor so that the reason is clear.

4.6 Show Ring production -The overall image has to be in keeping within the natural beauty of the Welsh breeds. Pulled and shortened manes and tails detract from this native look as does clipping of body hair. Exhibitors and Judges alike should be aware that production of this nature serves to do the Welsh breeds an injustice in the show ring. Any act of production which looks artificial and detracts from a 'native' look should be discouraged.

4.7 Tails should not be banded level or shaved.

4.8 Trimming for Shows - It is acceptable for Welsh breeds to have their head and throat trimmed and the hair protruding from the ears only. Animals 3 years and under must not

be body clipped

4.9 Whiskers must not be trimmed. Following the FEI General Assembly held on 23 November 2020, a new rule that prohibits the clipping/shaving of sensory hairs was passed as part of the veterinary regulations. This has been implemented on welfare grounds.

4.10 Clipping - Animals four years old or over, which have been clipped for winter riding and driving activities can be shown and should not be penalised. Judges must take special note of this. Legs must not be clipped.) Animals 3 years and under must not be body clipped.

4.11 Artificial changes to the original markings of an animal as recorded on the Passport will not be allowed.

4.12 Plaiting - Manes and tails must not be plaited with the exception of an optional single Welsh plait behind the ear for Sections A, B, C and D. Welsh Part-bred animals can be plaited.

4.13 Whips and Canes - The whip or cane must not exceed 75cm (30 inches) in total. Any use of plastic at the end of the whip/cane is prohibited.

Conduct

IN HAND CLASSES

4.14 - In the interest of safety all colts and stallions, two years old or over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler aged 14 years or older. Age as of 1st January.

4.15 - Handlers under the age of 14 must wear a current British Safety Standard Hard Hat, gloves (optional) and suitable footwear. Age as of 1st January. Young handler rules apply to both young handler and open classes.

4.16 - No colt/stallion or mare with foal at foot may be shown in young handler classes.

4.17 - Parents/guardians should be advised that the animal must be of suitable height and temperament for the handler and class.

4.18 - Children under 14 years of age must only show geldings or barren mares in open In Hand classes.

4.19 - No child under the age of 5 may compete in open In Hand classes.

In-Hand Tack

4.20 - Youngstock may be shown in a white webbing or rope show halter, leather head collar or show bridle (excluding two & three-year-old colts which must be bitted). Coloured brow bands are optional.

4.21 - Mares or geldings, four years old or over may be shown in a white webbing or rope show halter, leather head collar/slip, show bridle or riding bridle. Coloured brow bands are optional.

4.22 - Foals should be led in a halter or leather headcollar/slip. They must never be bitted.

4.23 - For stallions the use of stallion show tack is optional.

4.24 - Entire males, 2 years old or over must be shown bitted, with the exception of those in the Premium Stallion classes.

Foals

4.25 - Foals accompanying their dam must be at least three weeks of age.

4.26 - Foals must not be shod.

4.27 - Yearlings may be shod with light shoes only.

6.0 - PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES POLICY & PROCEDURES

6.1 - No animal, Pony or Cob shall be treated (whether under veterinary supervision or not) with any substance which may affect its performance in any way or with any, body or condition enhancing substance.

6.2 - All substances prohibited by the Jockey Club will be included (and any others which may be notified by the Society from time to time) and any substances used as agents to mask the use of performance and behaviour altering substances and any metabolites of such substances and any artificial growth or condition enhancing substances.

6.3 - It shall be a breach of these rules for any animal present at any show, event or competition with Society affiliation or where Society medals are awarded or at any official sale run under Society rules to contain any prohibited substances within its body or on its exterior.

6.4 - The making of an entry to any such show, event or competition or sale shall be deemed to accept the requirement to present an animal for testing for prohibited substances as may be required by the Society.

6.5 - Refusal to allow testing of any animal shall be a breach of these rules and shall be punished as if any subsequent test had proved positive.

6.6 - Any prohibited substances in the tissue, hair, skin, body fluids, excreta or body of an animal at any level or quantity shall be a breach of these rules.

6.7 - The Society shall direct at which shows or events or competitions or sales animals shall be tested. Choice may be computer generated at random. Tests may be required at random or for specific classes or whether performance, behaviour or The condition of an animal is noted to be unusual or different.

6.8 - Testing shall constitute the examination of the animal by a qualified person and include taking of samples, of tissue, hair, skin, and body fluids or etcetera as directed by the person examining for subsequent analysis.

6.9 - The samples shall be divided into two parts and the owner or person having care of the animal shall be offered one sample for independent testing at their own expense.

6.10 - The Society shall direct as to which laboratories are approved for samples to be tested.

6.11 - If a prohibited substance is confirmed by the laboratory in a sample, then: The animal will be disqualified from any prize championship or qualification and shall forfeit all placings, awards, or prize money in any classes from the day before it was tested and the outcome of a subsequent Disciplinary Hearing. The animal is suspended from being shown or taking part in any **WPCS AFFILIATED** show, event or sale pending the outcome of the subsequent Disciplinary Hearing. The owner and/or producer having care of the animal shall be suspended from all rights and privileges of membership of the Society pending the outcome of the subsequent Disciplinary Hearing. The period of suspension shall commence on the day after posting by the Society to the owner of the notification of a positive test result. The matter shall be reported forthwith to the Society for referral to disciplinary procedure.

6.12 - It is the responsibility of the owner of an animal or the owner's agents or producer or the person having care of an animal for fourteen days before and during a show or event to ensure that nothing is administered fed or applied to an animal that contains any prohibited substance.

6.13 - Lack of knowledge will not be an excuse nor a defence.

6.14 - IMPORTANT NOTES

Some feeds and proprietary preparations and homeopathic and herbal remedies may contain prohibited substances. Absorption can be by ingestion, injection or application through the skin. Before presenting an animal at a show, event, competition or sale it is advisable:

To obtain advice from a veterinary surgeon as to the length of time during which any prohibited substances may be present in an animal's body.

To obtain advice and confirmation from feed merchants or manufacturers as to the freedom of feed stuffs from prohibited substances.

6.15 - Sampling Procedures

a) Testing should take place as soon as possible after the participation of the pony in its class provided that it does not interfere with its programme in which case the test should take place as soon as possible after the pony has completed its programme.

b) It is the responsibility of the person in charge of the pony whether it be the owner or producer or other person to supervise the pony from the time of notification of selections for a test until completion of the test.

c) The owner, producer or other person responsible for the pony or his representative shall be entitled to witness the testing from outside the loose box, horse box or testing area without disturbing the pony but if not present the test will proceed in any event.

d) All samples taken must be kept in a secure place and dispatched to the laboratory selected by the Society as soon as reasonably possible after collection.

e) The sample must be divided into two parts hereinafter referred to as Sample A and Sample B and the initial analysis of Sample A must be completed within twenty-one days of receipt of the sample by the laboratory. If the initial analysis produces a suspicious positive result, then the Society may grant such extension as the laboratory requires to complete the analysis.

f) If the result of analysis of Sample A is negative, then the laboratory may forthwith destroy Sample B.

g) If the result of analysis of Sample A is positive then the owner or producer may require confirmatory analysis of Sample B, by any laboratory approved by The Horseracing Forensic Laboratory provided that a written request for such confirmatory analysis is received by the Society within fourteen days of dispatch by the Society of notification of a positive analysis of Sample A.

h) The owner or producer may request that finding be made in respect of particular matters during the analysis of Sample B on the basis that they will be responsible for all additional costs incurred whatever the result of the analysis of Sample B.

i) Upon receipt of a valid request for confirmatory analysis of Sample B, the Society shall inform the laboratory immediately and the laboratory shall carry out the analysis of Sample B.

j) If the result of analysis of Sample B is positive, then the person requesting the analysis shall reimburse the Society the cost of analysis of Sample A and Sample B forthwith on demand.

k) If the results of analysis of Sample A is positive and no valid request for confirmatory analysis of Sample B is received, the owner shall reimburse the Society the cost of analysis of Sample A forthwith upon demand.

l) The samples shall be taken by a qualified veterinary surgeon or a suitably qualified scientific technician.

THE ORSETT SHOW REGULATIONS FOR ALL HORSE CLASSES

- 1 The decision of the Judges shall be final. Objections of any kind must be made in writing and delivered to the Secretary making it clear that it is an objection which is being handed in. A deposit of £30 shall be paid with each objection which must be made within half an hour of the Judge's decision being given on the day of the show; in the case of a joint objection a deposit shall be paid by each objector. Such objections will be considered by a panel of not less than three members of the Society appointed by the Chairman or Vice Chairman and their decision shall be final. Anonymity will not be available to any objector. The deposit may be forfeited at the discretion of the panel
- 2 The Society's general by-laws and general regulations apply to all Entries, Exhibitors and persons attending the Show.
- 3 Exhibitors will comply with any directions or instructions given to them by the Society its Officers or Stewards, which the Society deems to be expedient.
- 4 Any animal considered by the Judge/Steward on the advice of the Veterinary Surgeons to be suffering from disease or lameness to be immediately removed from the class. The society and associated Show Veterinary Officers reserve the right to summon animal health officials if deemed necessary. All animals ridden anywhere on the Showground, rings or lorry parks, must only be ridden by a rider whose size and weight does not compromise the animal's welfare. We are operating under the 20% rider weight guideline where the rider in full riding attire with full tack must be less than 20% of the animal's body weight. This is based on a relatively fit, healthy animal, as an overweight animal is also a welfare concern. Every Exhibitor of Horses shall be liable to pay the society a sum not exceeding £100 and for liquidated damages, if any animal sent for exhibition is, in the opinion of any of the Show Veterinary Officers, affected with any contagious or infectious disease including ringworm, or with any form of disease likely to prove dangerous or detrimental to other animals and for each and every such case, if more than one. The aforesaid animal(s) will be disqualified and subject to movement restrictions must be removed immediately from the Showground.
- 5 It is the sole responsibility of riders to ensure that whilst on horseback, they wear correctly fitting, 3-point protective headgear which complies with the latest British Standard. The Society accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from a failure to comply with this regulation. The exception to this rule is for classes 40 & 42 whereby a **hat disclaimer** must be collected from the entry tent and signed if the rider wishes not to wear a hard hat and carried with them whilst on the showground and presented as they enter the ring. All riders and handlers under 16's will be required to wear hard hats when exhibiting.
- 6 No equine animal is allowed to be on the Showground unless entered in a class. Numbers need to be worn at all times whilst handling, riding or driving horses/ponies in the warm ups and collecting areas.
- 7 Every exhibitor making entries for the show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by these Rules and it is on this understanding only those entries are accepted. All entries to be made on line before the date specified in the Schedule. Showjumping and show entries will be taken on the day if an exhibit is already entered prior to entries closing but an additional fee will be charged.
- 8 The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry.

- 9 If for any reason the Horse Classes or the Show as a whole has to be cancelled ONLY half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will entries be returned.
- 10 In the event that a class or classes are cancelled by the Society (whether or not the Show takes place) then the only compensation due to an exhibitor will be a refund of the entry fee(s) paid by the exhibitor in respect of the class or classes that have been cancelled.
- 11 Except where this Schedule specifically provides otherwise for a particular class the following provisions will take effect. If there are less than six entries for any class, the third prize need not be given and if there are less than three entries, the second prize may be withheld.
- 12 Competitions qualifying for events organised by other bodies are offered in good faith on information provided by those bodies. No liability is accepted by this Society if those events take place in circumstances other than those originally stated or do not proceed.
- 13 Exhibits in all classes must be the bona fide property of the exhibitors and all exhibits must have been the property of, and in the possession of, the exhibitors at the time of entry. Any person who has care and control of an exhibit on the Showground will be deemed to be the Agent of that exhibit's owner for all purposes connected with that exhibit. The Horse Passports (England) Regulation 2009 requires all owners to obtain a passport for each animal that they own. Please remember to bring these passport(s) to the show and have them available for inspection if requested by Equine Veterinary Surgeon or Local Trading Standards Officers. If you require any further information please contact the DEFRA helpline or visit their website www.defra.gov.uk.
- 14 The entry fee for any animal entered and not exhibited will be forfeited.
- 15 In the event of a Judge or Judges failing to attend on Show Day, the Secretary or Chief Steward may appoint a Deputy or Deputies.
- 16 In any Class or Section which is affiliated to a Governing Body it shall be a condition of entry that exhibitors, whether or not members of that Body, shall comply with its Rules and will be liable to dope testing.
- 17 Every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing but should this happen for any reason; exhibitors must choose which class they want to compete in. No entry fees will be refunded. The Society will not be responsible for any loss where an exhibitor has made entries in more than one class and because of a time overrun it is not possible for him/her or the horse/pony to compete in one or more later classes. No claim for refund of fees paid or other loss, direct, indirect or consequential will be accepted or paid
18. The Show Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone
- 19 All cups and trophies are the property of the society. Most trophy winners may hold their respective cup or trophy and, upon payment of a refundable deposit of £70.00, this can be collected from the Show Secretary with the understanding that they must be returned by **July 15, 2027**. Winners will be required to engrave the trophies they have won at their own expense and sign for any trophies.
- 20 Livestock vehicles and horse boxes should follow the signs and enter the Showground at the designated entrances. Only vehicles carrying horses or turnout vehicles for driving classes will be permitted in the Horse Parking Area. Cars **MUST** not be brought in to this area and should be parked in the public car parks, clearly signed on all major routes to the

* Each **in-hand/ridden horse** entry will receive **two equine wristbands**. These wristbands allow entry for the **rider/handler and one groom** into the equine collecting ring and equine show rings.

* Each **driving/heavy horse** entry will receive **three equine wristbands**. These wristbands allow entry for the **driver/handler, groom, and assistant** into the equine collecting ring and equine show rings.

Additional wristbands may be purchased at the reduced rate of **£15** when submitting your entries. Please note that these additional wristbands are **NOT EQUINE WRISTBANDS**. They will allow entry to the showgrounds and access to view classes from the spectator areas only, and **will not permit access to the equine collecting ring**.

For health, safety, and insurance reasons, there will be **STRICTLY NO buggies, prams, pushchairs, etc. permitted within the equine collecting ring**.

Access to the collecting ring will be **STRICTLY LIMITED to those wearing an official equine wristband only**.

We hope you understand that all friends and family attending to support competitors will still be able to enjoy clear views of the arenas and judging. Classes will be judged facing outwards towards the show, rather than towards the collecting ring, ensuring everyone can safely watch and support those they have come to see.
