Thank you for your entry to Windsor Park Equestrian Club Regional Event 2023 and welcome.

PLEASE READ THE BELOW CAREFULLY AND FOLLOW ANY GUIDELINES.

WPEC considers itself very privileged to be able to welcome you all to the Deer Park, some areas are under Site of Special Scientific Interest conservation. It is important to us to maintain the integrity of the Park so there a few practicalities of management for everyone to remember and comply with.

Please remember there are wild deer within the park and the following rules are in place to protect the deer, the park environment, competitors, volunteers and spectators and the WPEC committee asks each competitor to respect the area and read and comply with the below rules.

Breaches of these rules by anyone associated with a competitor, may result in that **competitor's** disqualification from the event.

### GENERAL

Dogs must be kept on leads at all time. This is for the protection of the young fawns and deer calves currently in the park and is compulsory. Anyone violating this rule may be disqualified from the competition and asked to leave the park.

The use of Barbeques or similar is prohibited under The Crown Estate rules.

The Deer Park is heavily infested with ticks. Please be vigilant and check yourselves and your animals regularly. We **have a tick hook in the Secretary's caravan for anyone needing it.**

### ENTRY TO THE EVENT SITE

You may arrive after 2pm on Friday afternoon, please park where instructed.

**The gates to the park are locked at around 7pm each evening and reopen again at 7am. Attached is a map of how to get to the event. Our Postcode is SL4 2BD and What3Words are solo.lodge.sweep.**

### DEER

We are based within the Deer Park and as such there are wild deer around, who may in the evenings wander down to the arenas or around the obstacles. It is also fawning season which means that there are young fawns around, some will be sleeping in the long grass or may be near protective mothers. It is therefore very important that no one approaches any deer, whether adult or young, if you cycle, ride or drive in long grass, you must go walking pace slowly and be looking out for fawns, many of whom may recently have been born and therefore still be unsteady on their feet, asleep or resting in the tall grass.

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Dogs must NOT be let off leads in the Deer Park.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, and all event stewards and officials.

It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse at the event to wear a properly fitted and secured hard hat.

The ground beneath all temporary stabling, pens, electric fence enclosures and ground where horses/ponies are tied to the side of lorries for an extended period of time must be protected by matting. Any perforated or permeable matting must also have a waterproof membrane below it and bedding on top.

Please take home your household rubbish.

There is one walk in muck trailer for your convenience, please use this and do not make any heaps.

### Deer Park Gate

If the gate is unstaffed DO ALL OF THESE ACTIONS when opening / closing the gate.

Before opening the Gate:

Check for loose dogs, loose deer, loose horses and people & children nearby.

1. When closing the gate, ensure BOTH drop bolts are lowered onto the ground
2. Ensure the slide bolt is engaged across the gates
3. If the chain can be hooked up, please do so

Do NOT **leave the gate open for other users unless they are literally within “hand shaking” distance so the gates can be closed quickly.**

The main barrier to and from the road is padlocked at dusk and opened again around 7am. If you need to travel outside these hours, please liaise with the Stable Managers, Jeff and Mandy Bannister.

### MOTOR VEHICLES, BICYCLES AND ATVS IN THE PARK

Some parts of the Deer Park are Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) and as such we are limited on the amount of vehicle movements.

#### CARS/VANS/MOTORBIKES

Any car entering the Deer Park and Showground is only permitted to travel to and from the designated lorry park. Cars are strictly prohibited from all other areas, including to and from the obstacles. The exception is **officials'** vehicles when on WPEC duties.

#### BICYCLES & QUADS/MULES (ATVs)

It is The Crown Estate general rule of Windsor Great Park that no bicycles are allowed within the Deer Park or off road, however we have been granted special dispensation by the Deputy Ranger and Park Superintendent to let our competitors ride bicycles, quads\* or mules\* from the Lorry Park to and from the obstacles only. Anyone wishing to inspect the whole section B must do so on foot.

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\*The use of Quad bikes and mules will be allowed on condition the ground is dry. There will be a notice at the **Secretary's caravan stating whether Quads can be used. The only exception to this is for competitors with disabilities.** Please carry your British Carriagedriving Competitors with Disabilities Pass at all times.

This agreement is on the proviso that the following are adhered to:

### QUAD BIKES AND MULES

\*The use of Quad bikes and mules will be allowed on condition the ground is dry. There will be a notice at the **Secretary's caravan stating whether Quads can be used. The only exception to this is for competitors with disabilities.** Please carry your British Carriagedriving Competitors with Disabilities Pass at all times.

HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES by anyone riding on an ATV. Competitors using an ATV must hold a minimum of third party insurance cover and the vehicle must be road legal. Vehicles must not be ridden in such a way as to invalidate the insurance cover ie passengers can only be carried if the vehicle is designed to do so and has the correct number of seats.

COMPETITOR NUMBER BIBS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES when travelling on bicycle, quad or mule. This is to enable the Park Wardens to identify you as a WPEC Competitor and not a member of the general public. Anyone not displaying a number may be challenged by a Park Warden and made to walk back to the Lorry Park.

*Please be aware that as we are on The Crown Estate property if a Park Warden spots anyone riding or driving motor vehicles or ATVs in an unsafe, dangerous or illegal way they have the right to remove you from the showground and you will be disqualified from the event.*

### COMPETITION NOTES

#### Dressage & Cones

The attached dressage times are provisional and you should check at **the secretary's caravan in case of any** alterations. Please let the arena steward know you are there at least 10 minutes before your scheduled start time. After you have completed your dressage test, please make your way to the cones arena and let your arena steward know you are available. You will have your carriage measured on leaving the arena, so please follow the **steward's** instructions for this.

#### Warm Up Areas

There is a warm up / practice arena in the lorry park for use by all competitors. Approximately 10 minutes before your start time, please move around to the warm up area adjacent to the Regional Arena for your final warm up before your dressage test.

#### Pre Novice and Novice Dressage

There is a required safety check 30 minutes before your dressage time, Please ensure that you present yourself to the judge who will be near your arena so that you can be assessed prior to your dressage.

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### Novice Competitors.

Novice competitors your required carriage width is 138cm for dressage and cones

### Pre Novice Competitors.

Please note that your required carriage width is 125cm, ie marathon width. Therefore please do not extend your axles for the dressage and cones phases.

### Marathon

Please make sure you are at the Start A at least 10 minutes before your start time to allow for a safety check to be carried out.

### Vet and Farrier

Our Farrier for this weekend is David Matthews, he will be on call on Friday evening and Saturday and on-site all-day Sunday for any issues that may occur. Please speak to Pam in the caravan if you require him.

Our Vet is Tony Collins. He will be on call all of Friday and Saturday and will be in attendance on Sunday. If you need him at all, please notify **the secretary's caravan who will call him on your behalf.**

Any fees incurred for the use of David **or Tony will be the competitor's responsibility to pay.**
