RULES & REGULATIONS

*This show is intended as a warm up for the Horse of the Year Show 2022.
There will be music playing and lights – so please be aware of this.
Competitors do not have to have qualified for HOYS or be members of any Society
but must fit the criteria of the classes as outlined in the schedule.
All classes will be held in the indoor International Arena.*

- 1 **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
- 2 **THE SUBMISSION OF ALL ENTRIES THROUGH THE ON LINE SYSTEM** signifies acceptance of all rules and conditions.
- 3 **EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY PASSPORTS** – Exhibitors are required by DEFRA to carry with them Official Identity Documents for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a DEFRA requirement that the Official Identity Documents must be in the name of the legal owner.
- 4 **HORSES/PONIES** – An animal must be shown in the name under which it was originally registered with the Arab Horse Society, British Miniature Horse Society, British Show Horse Association, British Show Pony Society, Coloured Horse and Pony Society, National Pony Society, Native Breed Stud Books, Sport Horse Breeding (GB), British Showjumping or any other recognised Official Identity Document issuing society.
- 5 **INSURANCE:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the Showground or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he is responsible.
- 6 **JUDGING OF CLASSES** – no animal or rider may leave the ring without permission of the Judge and Ring Steward. Once the class has commenced there shall be no change of rider, except in a championship when a rider finds that they have more than one exhibit to compete. The substitute rider must be eligible for the class and the Ring Steward informed of the change of rider.
- 7 **COMPETITORS & JUDGES** – Exhibitors and competitors must not exhibit a horse under a Judge in circumstances that could constitute a breach of these rules. It is solely the responsibility of the exhibitor/competitor to make themselves aware of these rules and their eligibility to compete. Exhibitors/competitors are required to withdraw from a class if their participation is in conflict with any rules and regulations. For the purposes of this rule a Judge has an interest in an exhibit if he/she has:
 - Any horse/pony under the ownership or production of any person for whom he/she, his/her partner or business partner has provided or obtained livery or had any other connection (business or otherwise) since 1st January of the preceding year. Stud fees and associated costs are exempt as per society guidelines.
 - Any horse/pony that is or has been owned, bred, produced, trained or exhibited by him/her, immediate family, business partner or partner (NB: Group teach-ins and demos are exempt).
 - Any rider who has shown a horse/pony owned, produced or trained by him/her since the 1st January of the preceding year. (NB: Group teach-ins and demos are exempt).
 - Any horse/pony owned or produced by a person from whom the judge has purchased horses/ponies or to whom he/she sold horses/ponies since 1st January of the preceding year in which he/she is judging.
- 8 **FALL OF HORSE / RIDER** – a fall of horse or rider while mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they **MUST** leave the ring dismounted.
- 9 **THE AGE** of horses to be calculated from 1st January in the year of their birth.
- 10 **HARD HATS** – Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet current approved BSI or European Safety Standards **MUST** be worn by riders 18 years and under, riders competing in Intermediate, Competitors are reminded that hats should have a plain cover and should be as per the guidelines set out in the specific class and/or society ruling; black, navy, blue, brown, grey or green as appropriate. A rider whose hat comes off will be disqualified. A rider, whose strap comes undone whilst competing must on penalty of disqualification, replace it or fasten it before continuing. The rider may stop without penalty to refasten the strap.
- 11 **JEWELLERY** - No ear rings, piercings, or visible jewellery may be worn.

INTERNATIONAL ARENA A

Class 1 **RIDDEN LWT COB** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Class 2 **RIDDEN HWT COB** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Class 3 **RIDDEN MAXI COBS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 155cms.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 1-3 to compete.

Class 4 **RIDDEN COLOURED NATIVE / COB / TRADITIONAL PONIES** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms.

Class 5 **RIDDEN COLOURED NATIVE / COB / TRADITIONAL HORSES** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over exceeding 153cms.

Class 6 **RIDDEN COLOURED PLAITED HORSE / PONY** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 4-6 to compete.

Class 7 **RIDDEN LWT HUNTER** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 158cms.

Class 8 **RIDDEN MWT / HWT HUNTER** – mare or gelding, 4 year old & over, exceeding 158cms.

Class 9 **RIDDEN SMALL HUNTERS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 7-9 to compete.

Class 10 **SUPREME IN HAND LIGHT HORSE** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding. Any age (except no foals born in 2022), to exceed 148cms at maturity. To be shown in hand. Horses must have been placed first in their respective class at any show in the UK between 1st January and the date of this show.

Class 11 **SUPREME IN HAND LIGHT PONY** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding. Any age (except no foals born in 2022), not to exceed 148cms at maturity. To be shown in hand. Ponies must have been placed first in their respective class at any show in the UK between 1st January and the date of this show.

Class 12 **LADIES SIDE SADDLE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. To be ridden side saddle by a lady.

Class 13 **RIDDEN SMALL HACKS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms.

Class 14 **RIDDEN LARGE HACKS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 13-14 to compete.

Class 15 **SMALL RIDING HORSES** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 158cms.

Class 16 **LARGE RIDING HORSES** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 158cms.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 15-16 to compete.

INTERNATIONAL ARENA B

Class 17 **SHOW HUNTER PONY NOT EXCEEDING 153CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 153cms.

Class 18 **SHOW HUNTER PONY NOT EXCEEDING 133CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 17-18 to compete.

Class 19 **INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 20 **INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 19-20 to compete.

Class 21 **SHOW PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 148CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms.

Class 22 **SHOW PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 138CMS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 138cms.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 21-22 to compete.

Class 23 **RIDDEN PART BRED PONIES** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 148cms. To be shown plaited.

Class 24 **SUPREME IN HAND M&M** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding. Any age (except no foals born in 2022). To be shown in hand. Ponies must have been placed first in their respective class at any show in the UK between 1st January and the date of this show.

Class 25 **M&M LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 26 **M&M FIRST RIDDEN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 25-26 to compete.

Class 37 **JUNIOR RIDDEN M&M SMALL BREEDS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Open to Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 28 **JUNIOR RIDDEN M&M LARGE BREEDS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Open to Connemara, Dales, Fell Highland, New Forest, Welsh Sections C & D. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 27-28 to compete.

Class 29 **RIDDEN M&M SMALL BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Open to Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Sections A & B.

Class 30 **RIDDEN M&M LARGE BREEDS** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Open to Connemara, Dales, Fell and New Forest ponies.

Class 31 **RIDDEN WELSH SECTIONS C & D** – stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 29-31 to compete.

INTERNATIONAL ARENA C

Class 33 **SHOW HUNTER PONY LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their **9th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 34 **SHOW PONIES LEAD REIN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their **8th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 35 **SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their **10th** birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 33-35 to compete.
